Materials should be submitted in electronic form as a Word document.

- Full paper: up to 20,000 characters with spaces, punctuation or numbers
- Abstract: up to 4,000 characters
- Page settings: top and bottom -2 cm, left -3 cm, right -1.5 cm
- Font: Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing 1.25
- No page numbers

Text structure:

UDC index, presentation title (in uppercase, 14 pt), author's full name, position, full name of institution, city, country, abstract and keywords in two languages (original language and English), main text, list of references.

Bibliographic references must comply with the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015 "Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General provisions and rules for compilation."
